BISHOP LIAM S. MacDAID 1945-2023

The funeral took place last Saturday morning in St Macartan's Cathedral, Monaghan, of Most Reverend Bishop Emeritus Liam S. MacDaid, late of Monaghan and Bundoran. He was the Bishop of Clogher from 2010 until his retirement due to ill-health in October 2016. A native of Bundoran, Co Donegal, he was ordained a Priest in 1969. He was a member of the teaching staff of St Macartan's College, Monaghan for many years before serving as President of the College between 1981 and 1989. He later served in the Parishes of Fivemiletown, Co Tyrone (1989-93) and then Tyholland, (1993-2010). In addition, he was Diocesan Secretary and Chancellor from 1993 until his appointment as Bishop in 2010. Bishop Liam was much loved as a Bishop, priest and pastor, to all who knew him. May he now be rewarded for his many years of loyal and dedicated service to Christ and His Church. May he rest in peace.
