History talk on 23 May – ‘The 1828 “invasion of Ulster” and the meeting at Ballintra’

Patrick Duffy, PhD candidate in history at Trinity College, Dublin and IRC Postgraduate Scholar will give a talk on John Lawless’ ‘invasion of Ulster’ in 1828 and the meeting at what was then the Ballybay Catholic church located in Ballintra graveyard.
