Synod on Synodality - The final document from the 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod has been published and is available below as a working translation in English. In a departure from usual practice, Pope Francis said, "I want... to recognise the value of the completed synodal journey, which through this document I hand over to the holy faithful people of God.... There are already very concrete indications in the document that can be a guide for the mission of the Churches, on the different continents, in the different contexts: that is why I am making it immediately available to everyone." Our synodal pathway journey in Ireland and locally here in our diocese will continue over the months ahead, taking this as a guide.
