Parish Pastoral Planning - St Mary's Church

The parish pastoral planning group met last week on Ash Wednesday after mass. The following decisions were made for St Mary's Church.

1. The minister of the Eucharist will bring communion to choir members at the normal time.
2. Parishioners who wish to bring communion home to sick or older family members will bring Pyx with them as they themselves come forward for communion.
3. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place in Saint Mary's every Thursday during Lent from 7:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Any person who wishes to attend for the hour or part of the hour is invited to come along. The event will finish with Rosary at 7:45. The other 45 minutes will be for private prayer.
4. From next Sunday the words of the opening and closing hymns at Sunday Mass will be printed out and placed next to the bulletins. All at mass are invited to join in with the choir.

Parents and family members of children making their first Holy Communion or Confirmation this year are invited to a special children's mass on Sunday March 1st.
